

Dear Families,

Thank you for your patience and support this week as we've planned for and responded to the COVID-19 pandemic. Based upon the recommendation of trusted health professionals in our community, and in consultation with the synagogue's Board of Directors, we have decided to close Playschool for the next two weeks, beginning at 6 PM tomorrow (Friday, March 13).

We will continue to evaluate the situation during that time and make additional decisions accordingly. As of now, classes will tentatively resume on Monday, March 30. While there have been no confirmed cases of COVID-19 among members of our community, we have decided to be proactive in order to minimize the risk of exposure for everyone within the school community and beyond. In addition to Playschool closing during this time, all onsite synagogue services, activities, and programming have also been suspended.
