Dear parents,

We are thrilled at the opportunity to bring the Model Matzah Bakery, in collaboration with Society Hill Synagogue, to your kitchen!

The Model Matzah Bakery will take place at the time designated for your child's school / class. Please try to log in on time (or a few minutes prior).

We will be using ZOOM (zoom.us)

Under "Your Name" – Please enter your **child's first name and name of school (ex. Asher – Society Hill. They will not be "admitted" otherwise.)**

Please have the following items prepared:

- 1 cup of white flour (there are alternatives to white flour if you do not have. If no flour available, you can use playdough – of course no placing in the oven...)
- 1/4 cup of water
- Mixing Bowl
- Parchment paper or aluminum foil
- Rolling Pin (don't have one? Wine bottle, glass, and water bottle can work too!)
- Fork (for poking holes in the Matzah)

Now for a few tips:

1. Preheat your oven to the highest temperature
2. Google or YouTube search "homemade chef hat". We'd love to see your custom chef hat!
3. Have an apron? Go right ahead and put it on.
